- \$95 000 commitment to improve the Theatre from Sally Sitou (our federal MP)
- Lobbying for replacement of the roof in The Library and Common 6
- Air-conditioning of the Science common
- Removal of containers in the Senior Courtyard
- Lobbying that led to the major school upgrade
- New furniture for the Senior Courtyard
- New BBQ/Outdoor kitchen facilities
- Additional library resources
- An upgrade to all permanent student toilets
- Additional toilets to meet minimum requirements
