### **HSC Minimum Standards tests**

In term 3 students who did not meet the minimum standards in writing will be able to complete the online test. ## **Students taking minimum standard online tests this term- Monday Week 4 21st May Reading -period 3 Numeracy- period 5**

Just a reminder that we have enrolled a number of Year 10 students in this term's minimum standard online tests for reading and writing. The tests allow our students to demonstrate they meet the HSC minimum standard, which is required to receive the Higher School Certificate from 2020.

There are three tests the students must pass to achieve the HSC minimum standard – reading, writing and numeracy. Students will have the opportunity to sit the writing test in term 3. Students have two opportunities a year to meet the standard in each of these areas, from Year 10 until a few years after Year 12.

We also enrolled Year 10 students in practice tests so they could get used to the online test format and assess whether they were ready to take the tests.

Concord High School is in the initial stages of organising a school trip to Japan for ALL students of Japanese during the **2019** April holidays. At this stage it is envisaged 3 members of staff will accompany the students.

This excursion is open to all students studying Japanese in **2019**, including Year 12, however, it should be noted that students are expected to complete any school work due prior to or after the trip, and that this trip cannot be used as a reason for an extension or missing a task. Students will be responsible for their scholarly commitments and should consider the possible impact of this trip on their studies.

The trip will be over 13 nights and 14 days and will consist of some high school visits and travel to and sightseeings in Kyoto, Osaka, Kanazawa, Hiroshima and Tokyo.


The cost is envisaged to be around \$3950 and will cover airfare, hotel accommodations, breakfasts in hotels, and seven day Japan Rail Pass, a one day Tokyo Disneyland Passport. Students will need money for other meals, Local transports which are not covered by the Japanese Rail Pass, incidentals and personal spending.


