Thank you to all those people that came along to the last meeting for the year. What a great crowd, with lots of involvement and conversation. I will list the highlights below;

- **Wearing of the school tie** – this has been a topic of discussion for a few sessions this year and it was officially tabled at the last meeting, with a voted motion asking Principal Newby to consult the school community about making the tie optional, except for when representing the school off campus.
- **Request for funding from the Music Department** – Ms Ceste & Mr Jobson addressed the meeting explaining the details around their funding request for two Timpani Drums. This was timely as the P&C are currently introducing a draft version of a new process for funding applications to be completed and submitted to the P&C from the faculty Heads. This will give the P&C a full oversight of what the money will be used for.
- **New Big Roof Fan in Hall** – There was great excitement and laughter about the P&C funded big hall roof fan. Many in the room had seen and felt the effects of the fan. This was a great investment, make sure you check it out.
