**Project:** After great deliberation and investigation by the uniform shop subcommittee over a period of almost three years, that included the work practices, the work space and volunteer capabilities of running an onsite shop, it was voted by the P&C Membership to hand the business over to the School Principal.

**Handover Date:** September 2019

**Benefits of handing the shop responsibility over to the School:** The shop manager has an onsite contact at all times, the volunteers no longer handle wages/taxes and the Executive P&C volunteers are no longer responsible for the shops WHS regulations.

**The New Shop** – The new shop arrived in January 2020. A huge thank you to VP Linda Dunkin who took on the enormous task of transferring the uniform stock from a manual service process to an automated stock control process. Where after the stock take above was completed, all stock numbers could be monitored, tracked and forecasts could now be set up for the 2021 year 7 intake. This is now being handled by the school administration team and we look forward to even more dynamic methods of operating the uniforms shop in the future.
