

Concord High School return to school guidelines

Where possible parents are encouraged to keep their children at home except for their designated day/s. For families where keeping students at home is not possible, the school will be open and students will be supervised. No students will be turned away.

Please find attached a copy of your child's timetable including new rooming arrangements for Phase 1 Return to School.

Students will be continuing with "one single mode of delivery" as per the Department of Education guidelines. This single mode of delivery will be online learning for students in Year 7-10. Students will follow their normal school timetable and complete online lessons, google classroom activities set by their classroom teachers while being supervised.

Students in Year 11 will attend school all day on Tuesdays. Year 11 will not operate according to their normal Tuesday timetable. Rather a special timetable has been developed according to their subject choices and subject lines. Where possible, Year 11 will be taught by their regular class teacher in face-to-face lessons.

Students in Year 12 will return on a full-time basis and follow their normal school timetable. Year 12 students are required to bring their laptop and class books and will engage in faceto face teaching.

What do I need to bring to school?

Students are required to wear full winter uniform on return to school during term 2.

Students are required to bring their laptop, charger and headphones to school each day.

Students need to follow their normal school timetable. (Except Year 11). Each lesson students are required to log into their scheduled Google classroom and follow the instructions and activities uploaded by their classroom teacher.

Hygiene and Safety

Students who are displaying cold and/or flu-like symptoms will be asked to stay at home. If students present at school with cold and/or flu- like symptoms they will be isolated in an appropriate space, checked by the school nurse and if necessary asked to be collected by a parent/caregiver as soon as possible.

Classroom furniture has been re-arranged to leave as much space as possible between students and staff.

Students are required to:

- Implement appropriate social distancing measures. Students will be asked to keep 1.5 metres between each other when on the school premises.
- Wash hands frequently with soap and water before and after eating and after going to the toilet.
- Use the hand sanitiser made available to them when entering and exiting each learning space, after break times and before and after going to the toilet.
- Sneeze or cough into their elbow or a tissue.
- Avoid touching your face.
- Limit physical contact when greeting people, going to and from each class and in the playground.
- Sit at the same desk during the school day if they are in Year 7-10.

Canteen

The canteen will continue to operate; however, canteen meals will need to be ordered before school between 8.00- 8.55 am for pick up at recess or lunchtime. The use of the canteen will be staggered to support social distancing,

Picking Up Your Child During School Hours

Please send a note in the morning, with your child should they need to leave early. Parents can call the office to let them know that they are waiting at the front gate and students will be escorted to the gate by a staff member.

Morning Drop-off and After School Pick-Up

If walking or driving your student to school, parents are asked to drop their students at the front gate and not enter the school grounds.

Parents/carers should maintain social distancing whilst waiting for students.

If students are waiting for a bus, they will be supervised under the cola until their bus arrives and departs the School's premises.

Students are required to maintain social distancing whilst waiting for their bus and stand in the allocated area communicated by the supervising teachers.
